Health Impact Assessment (HIA) is an important tool to defend local communities from health and environmental risks. Nevertheless, to keep its promise HIA should be carried on within an open, well-informed, inclusive and dialogical approach. When the scientific evidence is distorted so as to serve vested interests and to endanger public health, what responsibility do scientists and scientific organisations bear? Scientists have the credibility to demand evidence-based public health policy that protects the right to health of all citizens.
